# Notes of General Interest

THE Chairman of the Regatta Commit se of each member club will file with the custodian of records, the entire list \* racing boats in each class, prior to the first race of the season. All boats wir then be considered as having been entered each race scheduled. If any boat decides to remain out of any race, the skipper or representative shall give notice of that fact, by 8 o'clock the evening preceding the race.

Commodore Adams of the Island Heights Yacht Club is the official Custodian of Records and list of entries and any substituent scratches will therefore be filed with Commodore Adams.

All point races are sailed not only for the trophies given out on the day of the race, but also for the championship of the Bay. The boat in each class winning the most points for the Season is presented with the championship pennant and trophy at the last race on Labor Day. The percentage standing is determined by dividing the number of points won by the number of points that could be won if the boat finished first. Every boat finishing is awarded one point for so doing, and an additional point for every boat in her class that she beats.

Bayhead Night Race, held on August 5. To be eligible to—Class A: Sailing Boats 18 ft. and over; Class B: Sailing Boats 18 ft. and under; Class E: E Sloops; Class G: G. Sloops.

Governor Hoffman Trophy for Class G Sloops will be presented on the last Race day on a basis of B. B. Y. R. A. points for the Season.

Changes in the B. B. Y. R. A. Rule Book, since its last publication May 15, 1937:

RULE 2—Corinthianism in yachting is that attribute which represents participation for sport as distinct from gain, and which also involves the acquirement of nautical experience through the love of sport, rather than through necessity or the hope of gain.

This rule has been amended by striking out the following sentence: No person who follows the sea as a means of livelihood or has raced for a Cash Prize shall be considered a Corinthian yachtsman.

RULE 30—The restriction placed on the crew of Snipes has been interpreted as a minimum of two.
