<u>Rudder</u>			
Wood material optional, size as per plans.			
<u>Mast</u>			
Mast to be solid, 3/4" diam round section			
Rectangular masts of 3/4" material and not less than 3/4" diameter permitted.			
Rotating masts not permitted.			
Height of mast from dock to top of main halyard above not to exceed 26' 3"			
Height to jib stay not to exceed 15'			
Center of mast from face to stem 7' 2" may be shifted to balance, not more than 2" at deck.			
Main boom to be solid; round or "T" section.			
Length from aft side of mast to end 12' 0"			
Foot of boom not to exceed 12' 0" must be fastened to boom for entire length.			
Tiller rod gears permitted.			
<u>Rigging</u>			
Masts to have one shroud only on either side and one jib stay. No spreaders permitted.			
Each stays optional.			
Details of rigging and fittings optional.			

Sails not to exceed the following dimensions:

Main-sail, hoist, 24'0" Foot 12'5" leach 25'0"  
Rations, three not to exceed 5'0" in length

Jib, hoist 17'4" Foot 7'6" leach 15'3"  
Jib to be loose footed and to set on jib stay.

Spinnaker: Back to Glem 12'0" Leaches 19'0"  
Spinnaker Boom Limited to 9'0" in length  
Spinnaker may be used no Dapon Fib.

A new boat may have two suits of sails the first  
year.

Restricted to one suit of racing sails of two  
Egyptian Sail Cloth for Main-sail and Jib.  
Must be McAllan's #40

Spinnaker shall be of 3.16oz Egyptian sail cloth  
must be McAllan's #38.

Restricted to one suit of working sails of not  
less than 6oz material. Must be McAllan's.

All boats are restricted to one new suit of racing  
sails every two years, i.e., At the beginning of the  
third racing year.

Racing number and class emblem must be on the Main-sail.

#### Equipment

Anchor weighing not less than 15 pounds.  
Anchor cable not less than fifty feet of 1/2" diam.

#### Ballast

No inside ballast permitted.

#### Crew

Limited to three persons when racing and maximum  
of four.

#### Measurement

Any complaint filed by any one racing against a  
boat as to measurement, or violation of sail  
measurement, the said owner shall bring his boat  
and sail for measurement by the committee and  
shall pay cost of measuring.

Age limit of Class-- 18 years

#### Bottle point:-

All boats shall be painted with soft copper

#### Hauling out:-

May be hauled out at anytime for cleaning.

Class racing name: "C" Class.

Racing rules: Racing of this class shall be under the R.A.Y.U. rules, and subject to the R.R.Y.C.R. rules not in conflict with the R.A.Y.U.

Then a member of any other club belonging to the D.R.Y.C.R. shall own a "C" Class Sloop, the said club shall appoint a member to this committee.

Trophy award: Perpetual award, trophy presented by H.S. Coffman, Governor of R.J., shall be raced for each year.
