TO RACE FOR THE NEW CUP.

Great Interest Being Shown in the Contest for the Morgan Trophy.

On Saturday of this week the race for the J. Willard Morgan cup, a new and handsome trophy, will be sailed for by the yachts of Island Heights, Seaside Park and Mantoloking Yacht Clubs. This will be an important event, as only yachts owned by private parties belonging to these clubs will be entered.

Heretofore the only trophy to be cailed for by these clubs has been the. Sewell cup, a handsome silver and goldlined piece, put up by the late United States Senator Sewell. The new cupoffered by State Comptroller Morgan, who is himself an enthusiast in yachting, will bring out greater rivalry than any cup yet offered, it is thought, and other yacht clubs may be permitted to contest for it before the season closes.

All the yacht clubs that will contest for these cups are made up of New York, Philadelphia, Trenton and Camden business men, who have their summer homes along Barnegat Bay and Tom's river.
